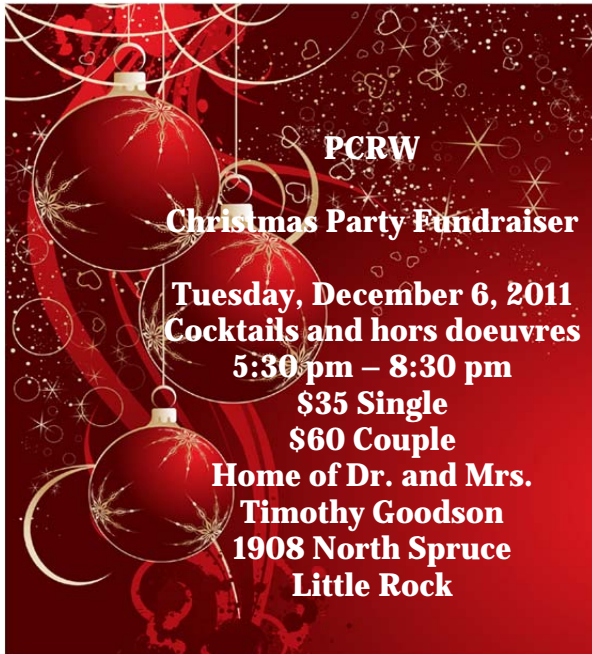

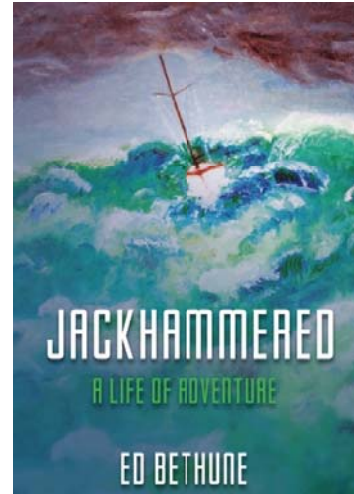

Congressman Bethune has just completed his first book: *Jackhammered, A Life of Adventure*. "Just as a jackhammer attracts our attention, the sailing trip in which Bethune almost died got his

attention. It forced him to look deeply into his past and think about his future".



Ed served in the U. S. Marine Corps from 1954-1957, earned his Juris Doctor degree from the University of Arkansas School of Law in 1963, served as the deputy prosecuting attorney of Randolph County from 1963 – 1964, as a special agent for the FBI from 1964 – 1968, as a prosecuting attorney for the First Judicial District of Arkansas from 1970 – 1971, and he served three terms in the United States House of Representatives from 1978 – 1985. YOU Can Attend Quorum Court Meetings!

We all need to be aware that our Justices of the Peace, who make up the Quorum Court (county government), spend literally millions of our tax dollars each year. If you think they only perform marriage ceremonies, you are in for quite a shock.

The PCRW highly recommends that you find out the name of the Justice of the Peace for your district and pay attention to how they are spending YOUR money.

As many people as possible need to begin to attend the Quorum Court meetings which are held the fourth (4th) Tuesday of every month (except December when they meet on the third (3rd) Tuesday). Meetings begin at 7:00 pm and are held at 210 S. Broadway, Suite 410. This is the building that is one block south of Robinson Auditorium on Broadway.

The main phone number of the Quorum Court is 501-340-8310. Call that number to get the contact information on your JP. You can also go to www.co.pulaski.ar.us/quorumcourt2.shtml to find contact information. An informed public is the best defense against intrusive government.

Each JP serves on one or more committees. Committees meet the second (2nd) Tuesday of each month: Ways and Means: 5:30 pm, Administration: 6:00 pm, & County Services: 6:30 pm. The public needs to attend these meetings as well to keep our JP's accountable to the people
